Founded in 1949, the Community Theatre of Greensboro is the oldest Arts organization in Guilford County.

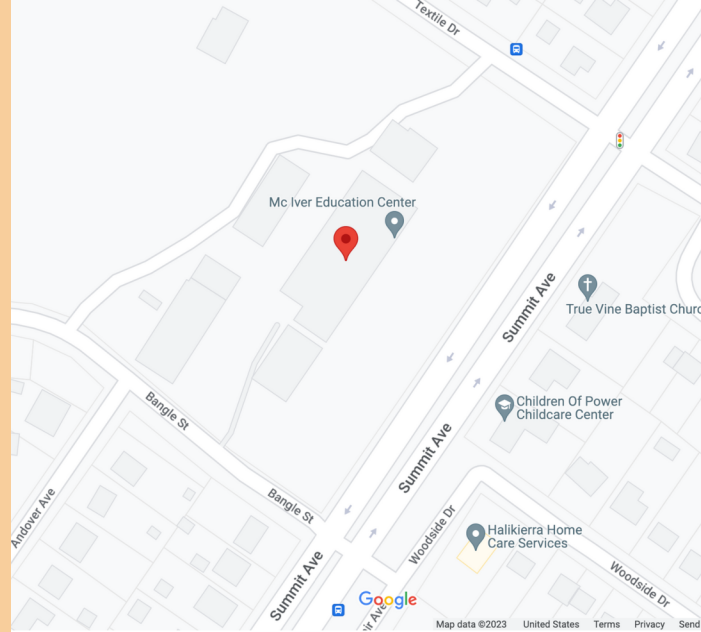
What sets CTG apart? Our focus on reaching out to our entire community and concentrating on our mission:
